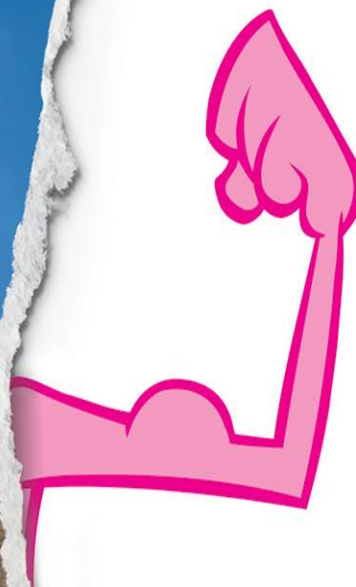

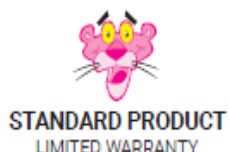

Owens Corning® architectural shingles create greater integrity and better holding power on the roof to protect your home. When our Oakridge® and Duration® Series shingles go head-to-head with competing products in three critical tests, the results are impressive. Our products outperform in resistance to nail pull-through, nail blow-through and delamination.



TEST 1

NAIL PULL-THROUGH RESISTANCE

Simulates the wind force it takes to pull the shingles off a roof deck. Shingles with higher nail pull-through resistance offer better protection against high wind.

TEST 2

NAIL BLOW-THROUGH RESISTANCE

Measures the number of nails that are over-driven when using the same nail gun pressure. Over-driven nails require an additional nail for secure fastening, which means more holes in your roof deck.

TEST 3

DELAMINATION RESISTANCE

Tests the ability of the shingles to resist layer separation when heated to 180°F. Shingle delamination can negatively impact roof performance and aesthetics.

IBHS Impact Testing & Ratings Performance vs. Competition

Summary

The January 2020 issue of Consumer Reports issues includes a section that rates asphalt shingles. It's the first time the publication has looked at this product in more than 10 years.

- Products rated based on 4 different features: Strength, Wind, Nailing, Impact
- **Duration was top rated in the Architectural Laminate Shingle category.**
- **Berkshire was top rated in the Multilayer Architectural Laminate Shingle category (premium laminates).**
- Supreme was not reviewed in the 3-Tab Shingle category.
- The article does not rate the product aesthetics, only some basic performance features.
- **Ventilation and attic insulation are reported among the ways to help your roof last longer.**
- **Article recommends getting a warranty upgrade by using the shingle manufacturer's other roofing components because they've been tested together.**
- **Calls out OC Contractors, because they can offer extended warranty coverage.**
- The publication's results relative to shingle weight are encouraging.
 - *Shingle weight is mentioned, but products were not rated based on that factor.*
 - *Heavier shingles tended to rate lower.*
 - *Demonstrates that lighter shingles perform as well or better than heavier ones in the CR tests.*
- Tests not performed by the publication that are also important to consider for shingle performance include:
 - *Seal-ability*
 - *Nail blow through resistance*
 - *Granule Retention*

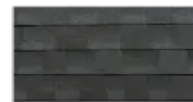

IBHS Test Results – June 2023

-Insurance Institute for Business and Home Safety

-New testing protocol that uses artificial hail stones. Vs. 2" steel balls.

-Rated on 3 criteria

-UL2218 (steel ball test) is still standard used by insurance companies

-Polymer type/make-up differs by each manufacturer.

-Stiffer polymers more brittle in cold weather.

-Weight no bearing on performance
